Could you tell us a little bit about yourself?

What books have had the greatest influence on you?

Sir Walter Scott's "Ivanhoe" was the book that piqued my interest in British history and the early Middle Ages, and "The Long Ships" by Frans G. Bengtsson brings the Viking era to life.

I have created profiles on numerous book promotion sites, have donated books to be included in silent auctions at community events, and have participated in contest giveaways on social networking book catalog websites.

How do you spend your time when you are not writing?
